
Joyce Neville's mixed media collage, ' Revitalization ' has been selected to be in the Newport Annual Members ' Juried Exhibition 2016.

**Entries**: Each artist may submit two entries (original works only)

Entry Fee: There will be an entry fee of \$5.00. You may enter 2 paintings. No fee required for art work in the bin.

Size: Not to exceed 20 inches on longest side (including frame)..

Sales: Entries "NOT FOR SALE" must be so marked (NFS). EGAC's commission on all sales is 10% of the selling price.

Delivery/drop off: Friday, April 1, 2016, between 10:00 am - 1::00 PM, at the Warwick Public Library...

Opening Reception: Sunday, April 10, 2016, 2:00 - 4:00 PM

**Show Hours:** April 2, – April 25, 2016. Library hours, Monday – Thursday 9 am – 9 PM. Friday and Saturday 9:00 am – 5:00 PM, Sunday 1 PM – 5 PM.

**Pick-up**: Works should be picked up TUESDAY, April 26th, between 12 noon - 5 PM.
