Tickets are \$14.50 round-trip or \$7.25 for Seniors over 65. Parking is \$4.00 have the cash ready for parking either dollar bills or coin.

The train will leave at 8:45 or there is another train at 11:30. Get off

the train at Back Bay Station and go to the Greenline outbound subway, which is near the public library and proceed to MFA . Tickets for the MFA are \$15.00 for Seniors and \$17.00 for Kids under 65.
