Speaking of the East Greenwich Library, *John McDonough* is having a one-person show there from April 5-30.

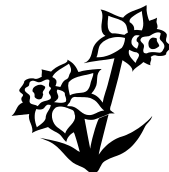
*Tom Martino* is having an Opening Reception April 17 from 10 am to 2 pm at Java Madness Coffee House at Salt Pond in Narragansett.

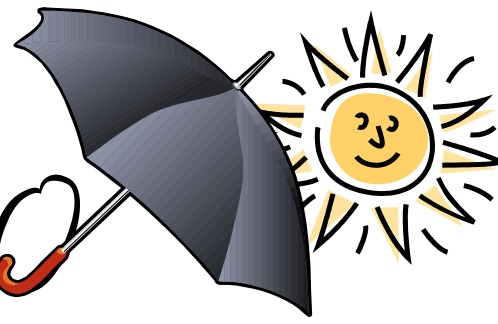

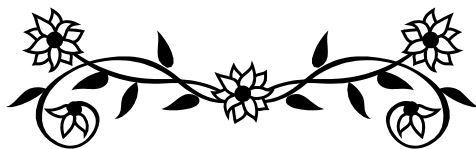

## LOOKING FOR ACRYLIC WORKSHOP INSTRUCTORS

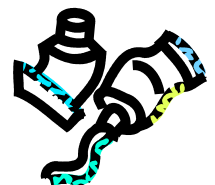
If you are an acrylic artist capable of demonstrating a landscape, seascape, floral, and still life, please read on:
