

### May 2023 President's Message IMPORTANT BUSINESS THIS MONTH

Please plan to attend the May meeting if at all possible.

• We will begin the meeting with an important proposal!!

Our original Bylaws had THREE major purposes stated. Sometime in the distant past one of these purposes was dropped, perhaps because it was deemed unattainable (?).

# The statement: "...thirdly, to bear in mind the need for a club house and conduct the club and its activities in a manner conducive to the realization of this aim."

We have established a comfortable place for our educational meetings; we have set up a small gallery space to be a presence in the downtown East Greenwich area; we have built a partnership with the Town of East Greenwich's Recreation Department to have a place to hold workshops. All these actions are affordable within our existing budget.

These actions have helped us rebuild our organization to 60 members after COVID reduced us to 20!

When the organization was faced with the possibility of disbanding in 2019, we had to consider the fact that the Club had a sizeable CD that was sitting in a bank account. What would happen to it if we disbanded the organization?

At our May meeting, I will propose we reconsider the third goal considering increasing membership, a strong Board, and the savings in our bank account.

I will open this question for discussion: "Should the East Greenwich Art Club reestablish the third goal stating that the Club will *"Conduct activities that can support the aim of establishing a single location in which to conduct business, hold educational meetings and workshops, and exhibit works of art to the public."*?

- For the second part of our May meeting, we will display works of art by our members that honor our pets and animals.
- Our June meeting will feature two area artists who will show exemplary works of art and discuss their experiences as members of two different artist "Cooperatives" in Rhode Island so we may better understand if that is a direction to explore for the future.

## **About Town – Supporting Fellow Artists**


\*Ann Bianchi will be a demonstration plein air painter for two upcoming events:
