White Line Woodcut Printmaking

This class will take students through the history of white line woodcut, widely considered the sole American woodcut technique, to basic carving skills, painting techniques, and making prints. By the end of the class, students will have a good understanding of basic white line woodcut printmaking, and will be introduced to more advanced techniques if time allows.
